Certificate III in Aged Care - CHC30208

If you would like to work in the in the Aged Care Industry the Certificate III in Aged Care is the minimum qualification required to work in this industry.

Certificate III in Aged Care allows you to access employment caring for the aged in services such as high or low level residential facilities, supportive care or the community. These services will expect graduates to be proficient in skills such as health monitoring, personal care, environmental and social support and information and advocacy services.

Students will learn clinical skills such as Medical Observations, NoLift and Manual Handling. Accreditation Standards and Employability Skills are embedded into the course.

This course will give you the skills and knowledge to work as a;

- Care Assistant
- Nursing Assistant
- Home Care Assistant in an Aged Care Facility or within the Community.

The education and training you'll receive from studying a Certificate III in Aged Care program will open the door to a range of exciting career paths in care assistance and community support work.

This course can also be delivered under our traineeship program. Hub traineeships provide an opportunity for working people to learn and gain experience whilst achieving a Nationally Recognised Qualification.

If you are entering this program as a Trainee under the Australian Apprenticeships arrangements, you must be employed in the industry and you must register with an Australian Apprenticeships Centre (AAC) prior to enrolment.

Course Fees

Course Delivery

This course will be delivered flexi-delivery with a combination of classroom based and project based learning. Traineeship delivery is also an option.
