Certificate IV in Aged Care – CHC40208

Certificate IV in Aged care addresses work primarily in residential facilities. This course is designed to provide you with the knowledge, skills and professional attributes for becoming team leaders and managers of complex care both in low care aged facilities and the community.

Workers with this qualification:

- Carry out activities related to maintaining an individual's well being through personal care and/or other activities of daily living
- Provide services to individuals with complex needs
- May provide training and support to promote independence and community participation as part of activities and programs in a variety of settings
- Report to service managers and liaise with professionals
- May supervise and coordinate a limited number of other workers

Occupational titles may include: Assistant Hostel Supervisor, Care Team Leader, Day Activity Worker or Social Program Coordinator

** There are entry requirements to be met before studying this course:*

This course can also be delivered under our traineeship program. Hub traineeships provide an opportunity for working people to learn and gain experience whilst achieving a Nationally Recognised Qualification.

If you are entering this program as a Trainee under the Australian Apprenticeships arrangements, you must be employed in the industry you must register with an Australian Apprenticeships Centre.

Students must be recognised as competent against the following compulsory units from CHC30208 Certificate III in Aged Care

Students must pass an entrance literacy and numeracy exam for this qualification level and should currently be employed in the Aged Care industry in a personal care role.

Students must successfully complete all 15 units to be awarded the qualification.
