Certificate IV in Community Development – CHC40808

Certificate IV in Community Development is ideal for those already with experience in industry through paid employment or volunteer positions who require a recognised qualification, an upgrade of skills or the development of skills. This qualification aims to give you the skills and knowledge to facilitate community members to work together to influence and guide the future of their community.

Certificate IV in Community Development covers a wide range of useful skills that can cross over a number of sectors within community services including;

- social
- environmental
- economic
- arts and culture / recreation

If you are entering this program as a Trainee under the Australian Apprenticeships arrangements, you must be employed in the industry and you must register with an Australian Apprenticeships Centre (AAC) prior to enrolment.
