## INFORMATION SHEET

### **Certificate IV in Home & Community Care – CHC40208**

Certificate IV in Home and Community Care provides students with the skills and knowledge to work in client homes and other community settings within defined organisational guidelines and service plans.

Workers with this qualification can expect to carry out activities related to maintaining an individual's well being through personal care and/or other activities of living; may provide services to individuals with complex needs, and/or work with groups of older people. Work may include training and support to promote independence and community participation, which may be provided as part of activities and programs in a variety of home and community care settings. They will report to service managers and liaise with professionals and other service providers and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a limited number of other workers.

It is an industry requirement that all Home and Community Care Workers have a current (within last 6 months) National Police Clearance to be able to work in Australia. Participants registering in this course must be able to obtain a clear police clearance. A copy of the certificate must be provided to Hub before you can participate in the practical work experience component of this course.

#### **Occupational titles may include:**

- Assistant coordinator
- In-home respite care
- Assistant team leader
- Community support worker
- Personal care worker
- Support worker
- Care team leader
- Day activity worker

#### **To gain entry into this course a candidate must be recognised as competent against the units:**

- CHCAC318A Work effectively with older people
- CHCDIS301A Work effectively with people with a disability
- CHCICS304A Work effectively with carers

This course can also be delivered under our traineeship program. Hub traineeships provide an opportunity for working people to learn and gain experience whilst achieving a Nationally Recognised Qualification.

If you are entering this program as a Trainee under the Australian Apprenticeships arrangements, you must be employed in the industry and you must register with an Australian Apprenticeships Centre (AAC) prior to enrolment.

### **Course Fees**

### **Course Delivery**

This course will be delivered flexi-delivery with a combination of classroom based and project based learning. Traineeship delivery is also an option.
